While we truly appreciate the many benefits these types of exchanges bring to our school and families, it is important we use a set of common guidelines to protect our families and staff from false accusations, privacy violations and any related legal implications.

St. Josaphat Parish School considers its social media platforms to be moderated and limited public forums . As a result, SJPS reserves the right to remove comments that are clearly off-topic and inappropriate, including:

- Profane or obscene language or content
- Content that promotes, fosters, or perpetuates prejudice or discrimination against protected classes
- Sexually harassing, lewd, bullying, harassing, or discriminatory content
- Conduct or encouragement of violence, criminal activity, or truancy (please note that threats made against school property is a felony under state law and persons who communicate threats will be reported to law enforcement)
- Spam or comments that include links to external online sites
- Comments that exist only to provoke or mislead
- Commercial solicitations or advertisements including promotion or endorsement
- Promotions of particular services, products, or political candidates or organizations
- Information that personally identifies students or otherwise infringes on a child's legal rights related to education
- Information that is profane, slanderous, or defamatory against SJPS personnel or staff
- Information that may tend to compromise the safety or security of individuals and/or our school.

SJPS reserves the right to ban commenters who repeatedly breach the guidelines above. Wisconsin Statutes 19.31-19.39 require us to archive all social media posts (including all comments deleted by individuals and SJPS) in compliance with public records laws. ALL posted, edited and/or deleted comments are archived.
